The team offer immersive experiences and adventure for individuals and groups by providing bespoke, tried and tested activity packages anywhere in Northern Ireland. Paddlesport is their main passion, with canoeing and kayaking experiences and they even have a giant SUP. Many other experiences are offered from birthday parties, team days to family days, which might include climbing one of their mobile climbing walls or a spot of laser tag.

Their clients include youth organisations and corporate businesses; community days are a specialism. Crucially, flexibility is integrated into the offer, by letting clients choose venues or locations. Alternatively, groups and individuals come to their activity base, in Belfast; but they also have a strong presence in Ards and North Down.

Mobile Team Adventure was set up by John Hubbucks in 2005. His and the company's ethos is about quality and guests' enjoyment – "...we want you to go home at the end of the day with a smile on your face and a real sense of achievement."

Safety is paramount, with experienced instructors trained and qualified to National Standards in their field, as well as in First Aid, Child Protection and Leave No Trace. **Mobile Team Adventure respect the environment around them, and believe they are reducing their Carbon Footprint by going to larger organisations, instead of individuals driving to them.**

Mobile Team Adventure's sea kayaking 'Glide with the Tide' on Strangford Lough was selected as one of the experiences to be featured in NI's 2020 tourism promotion Embrace a Giant Spirit.

Strangford Lough is of international importance for wintering wildfowl. An area of outstanding natural beauty, the landscape here is diverse, and the adventure might include foraging for mussels and enjoying an Irish smorgasbord of some of the finest foods from local Strangford producers – some delicious cheese and a taste of Northern Irish small-batch pickle.
